

Health Services at Wren Middle School

Registration:

While registering your student, please be sure to review and update the medical information form. For example, if your child was diagnosed with asthma as a small child, but no longer requires an inhaler or nebulizer, please remove asthma as a medical concern. This will prevent you from receiving additional, unnecessary paperwork in the future and ensure our school health records are current.

If your child currently has an IHP (individual health plan), please be sure to take the IHP for this coming school year to the doctor with you over the summer. If you have not received one yet, please contact your child's elementary school nurse to receive it.

Medications:

The school nurse does not keep "extra" medication on file in the health room to administer to students. Only medication provided for a specific student can be administered to that student.

***** Students are not allowed to carry medications on themselves and/or self-administer medications at school.*****

Vaccines:

The Tdap vaccine is required before entry into the 7th grade. If you are taking your child to the doctor this summer or next school year for an exam, it is not too early to receive this vaccine. If your child does receive this vaccine or has already received it, please submit a copy of their immunization record at registration in the fall.
